Deborah Deming Memorial Scholarship Fund – *Open to continuing UGS Students*

The Deborah Deming Scholarship fund provides \$2,500 per year in financial assistance to continuing Undergraduate Studies students who have taken and successfully completed the required “Educational Foundations” orientation course, and who can demonstrate that they are deeply motivated and committed to advocating for sustainability and its practices.

Additional Criteria/Documentation

- One-page essay answering the following questions: How in your personal life and school work have you incorporated sustainable and ecological principles? How do you inspire sustainability now? How will you raise awareness after graduating Antioch?

Stephen Leiter Scholarship – *Open to UGS Students*

The Stephen Leiter Scholarship is awarded to Undergraduate Studies students whose research, experience or future goals include an international perspective or interest, and whose commitment to those international issues is incorporated into their educational career and life.

Additional Criteria/Documentation

- 500-word essay explaining the student’s research, experience or future goals that include an international perspective, or address international issues or interests.

Douglas Sadownick Scholarship – *Open to continuing MAP Students*

The Douglas Sadownick Scholarship is awarded to continuing students who have taken at least one LGBT Specialization class.

Additional Criteria/Documentation

- 500-word essay answering the following questions: How would you integrate your leaning from LGBT Specialization classes into your clinical practice and/or future activism on behalf of the LGBT community?
