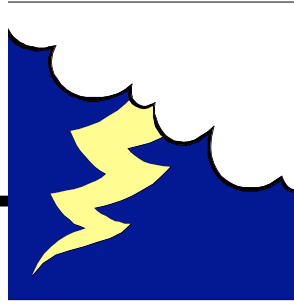


Brainstorming



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Problem or Key Idea

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Rules:

1. All ideas are okay to include — even “wild” ideas!
2. It is okay to add on to someone else’s idea.
3. The more ideas, the better.

Follow-Up

1. Start with all your ideas.
2. Think of some rules for keeping or getting rid of some of them. Examples: “We’ll keep an idea if it is fun”, or “We will cross out all the ideas that are impossible.”
3. Circle, star, or highlight the ones that fit.
4. Discuss ways to choose the ideas you like.
