Finally: Admission to the Clemente Veterans Initiative requires a commitment on your part to attend two nights per week from orientation to graduation: January 2nd - June 14th 2018. There will be reading, writing, and conversation in the classes and your participation will deepen and enrich your classmate's learning. In addition to a 6 hour continuing education course on Veteran's education access, the course surveys five humanities subject areas: Philosophy; U.S. History; Art History; Literature; and Critical Writing for a total of 120 hours. The courses will be taught by expert college-level professors who will be sensitive to your experience and who will challenge you to do your best. You will receive a certificate of completion at the end. You will also have the option of fulfilling requirements for a transcript and transferable college credit from Bard College in New York. You are the essential ingredient for the success of the course. It will be crucial for you to attend as much as possible to optimize this learning opportunity for everyone involved.
