## Resolving Difficulties: Ways to Address Concerns and Be Heard

### Who can I talk to on campus when I am struggling academically?

There are various services on campus to address your concerns; Disability Support, Academic Support Lab, and Student Life. There is also free, unlimited counseling in the AUS clinic for all student veterans enrolled at AUS. Contact the Vet Corps Navigator for more information.

### What are the steps to resolve academic or behavioral concerns?

First, speak with your instructor or peer about the issue. Second, speak with your advisor. If your concerns are not addressed appropriately, discuss matters with the Dean of your degree program. If your issue has not been resolved to your satisfaction, or you are not comfortable addressing your concern with people within your program, speak with the Vice President of Student Affairs, Shana Hormann.

### How do I resolve financial concerns?

Financial aid, the Registrars' office, and Student Accounts. Additionally, the Vet Corps Navigator can connect you with a student veteran peer.

### What can AUS veteran services do for me? The Vet Corps Navigator can connect you to:
