REFUND POLICY

Tuition Refund for Dropped Courses: 100% tuition credit is granted for courses dropped by 20% of the instruction period for that course. No tuition credit is given after 20% of the instructional period for that course.

Tuition Refund for Withdrawal from the Term (all courses dropped) is prorated and credited to a student's account for courses dropped prior to or by the second class session, or the 14th day of enrollment, whichever is later. The refund is calculated from the date the student submits written notification of the withdrawal to the Student Services Office. The University provides a pro rata refund of unearned institutional charges to students who complete 80 percent or less of the period of attendance. If the University cancels or discontinues a course, the University will make a full refund of all associated tuition charges. Refunds are paid within 30 days of receipt of notification of cancellation or withdrawal. Please note that this new refund policy is effective beginning the Summer 2016 term.

Take the Educational Foundations Class.

In this class you will:

- **Develop your degree program**
- **Set personal, career and academic goals**
- **Sharpen your critical thinking and communication skills**
- **Improve your writing and organizational skills**
- **Learn how to document prior life learning to earn college credit at AUSB**
- **Earn 3 units of required credit towards your BA degree at AUSB**

The Educational Foundations course is a required class for every AUSB BA student and must be taken in the student's first quarter. Prospective students may also register for the class before actually applying to the BA program. The cost, for a non-matriculated student, is \$495* for the three-unit class. As a prospective student you may want to take this class before submitting a formal application for several reasons: you may be completing another academic program or find yourself too busy with work or family to start a full program now. Some prospective students feel apprehensive about returning to school and want to test the waters before taking the plunge.

In the Educational Foundations course, students are introduced to the Core Purposes of a Liberal Arts education and develop skills relating to critical thinking. The course also serves as a writing workshop and provides an individualized learning program for each student. Educational Foundations can be taken during or before the first quarter of study.

Classes often fill up before the first meeting so try to register early. However, if space allows, you may register for this course at the first session and pay the \$495 fee by check at that time. For further information, contact the Student Services Office at 805-962-8179.
