Professor and Distinguished Senior Scholar at Antioch University, New England, board certified in clinical psychology through the American Board of Professional Psychology, and a well-respected private practitioner, Dr. Peterson has been a foundation for the National Council of Schools and Programs of Professional Psychology (NCSPP). As Past-President of NCSPP, he chaired national conferences; was senior editor of The Core Curriculum in Professional Psychology; senior author of "The National Council of Schools and Programs of Professional Psychology Educational Model;" and co-editor of Competency-Based Education for Professional Psychology that includes an updated model paper. He received the NCSPP Distinguished Professional Psychologist Award for Exemplary Contributions to Professional Psychology Education in 2008. Also, a major contributor to accreditation, Dr. Peterson served on the American Psychological Association's Commission on Accreditation for 11 years.
