N/A. We do have a waiver policy. Waivers grant permission not to take a particular course in the program; they do not reduce the required number of credits to graduate, or shorten the program. A student who is granted a course waiver selects an alternative course to take instead. The program remains full time, and except for transfer students, it cannot be shortened. Students granted transfer credit for less than one full year may be given advanced standing and may have a reduction in tuition.
