COUN 5002 Foundations Residency & COUN 5002 Group Residency

Residency provides counselors and art therapists- in- training with the opportunity to practice art therapy and counseling skills with clinical supervision from the residency instructor. Throughout the residency students are expected to engage in practice sessions with peers and apply feedback from peers and instructors to improve clinical counseling and art therapy skills.

Successful completion of COUN 5902 Foundational Skills, and COUC 5402 Techniques & Practices, and COUN 6030 Group Counseling (AT) are prerequisites in order to attend Residency. Residency is a 0 credit 4-5 day intensive clinical training requirement for all CMHC students to develop and demonstrate in-person clinical skills and provides, in-person clinical development, direct assessment of counseling skills, evaluation of professional dispositions, and faculty observation and direct feedback. Residency is a non-credit graduation requirement, a CACREP requirement and a prerequisite for beginning practicum.

Residencies are stand-alone program requirements and not embedded within the tuition for any academic course, they carry a separate fee. Residency is \$1,495.00 and includes, and breakfast and lunch each day. Students are responsible for accommodations and travel expenses as well as any meals outside of Residency.

Residency will be held on one of the Antioch University Campuses, which includes Antioch Midwest in Yellow Springs Ohio, Antioch Seattle in Seattle, WA, Antioch New England in Keene, NH, and affiliate school Otterbein University in Westerville, OH. Applicants should consider the travel cost of each residency given their current living location and potential cost for accommodations and meals for at least 6 days. Students will receive detailed information about Residency location in the semester before Residency.
