**Become a Teacher Librarian** with Antioch University Seattle's School Library Endorsement, a Washington

state-approved, competency-based endorsement that provides skills and knowledge for developing a school library program centered around supporting students' critical learning. The program is available online or with some hybrid options with AUS faculty traveling to you onsite. Antioch has reciprocal certification agreements with other states and will help out-of-state students earn school library certification.
