Community Garden Connections (CGC) serves to build our local capacity to grow food and enhance personal and communal well-being among those most impacted and disenfranchised by climate change, Covid-19 and other social, economic, and ecological injustices. CGC offers safe places for community members to get outside, learn, and connect through gardening. It addresses food insecurity related to climate change, personal and communal health, and resiliency. With the help of a private donation from the Rashti Foundation, CGC supports the installation and cooperative maintenance of 70+ raised gardens in partnership with local service agencies, students and community members. These funds also support educational outreach to meet the specific gardening interests of community partners.
