Education Programs at Antioch University New England value collegueship and strong learning communities, which is why we offer a 10% discount for 3 or more students employed by the same school or school district who attend any of our AUNE Education M.Ed. or Certificate programs at the same time. How to Apply

- Students become eligible for the discount during any semester when there are 3 or more students who are employed by the same school or district enrolled in an M.Ed. or Certificate Program in the Education Department at AUNE.
- If one of the 3 people who makes you eligible for the discount withdraws or completes their program, you will still receive the full amount of your discount.
- If you are a new student, you may apply for the discount during registration but before you make payment for your first term.
- Continuing students can apply as soon as they become eligible (a new colleague is admitted, for example) and the discount will be applied to their next registration term.
- Once the Education Department has confirmed your eligibility for this discount it will be applied to your bill in the following semester.

Conditions and Limitations:

- The 10% discount is a fixed amount per term, calculated based on tuition at the time the you become eligible and continuing until the you complete your program or the minimum anticipated time to completion is met, whichever comes first.
- The discount is not 10% of each bill, but rather a set amount off per term regardless of the bill. For example, if your total program cost is \$25,000, your total discount will be \$2500 evenly divided by the minimum number of terms to completion. So, if the program normally takes 5 terms, you will receive a discount of \$500 per term.
- You must be enrolled at least ½ time (3 credits) to be eligible for the discount in any given term.
- The discount amount will not go up if tuition goes up during your program because it is not calculated at 10% individually per term. It is a fixed amount set when you become eligible for the program.
- If you extend your program beyond the minimum number of terms to completion, your discount will run out after the total amount has been paid. So, if you receive a total discount of \$2500 and stay 6 terms instead of 5, you will not receive any discount in your final term.
- You will not receive a larger discount per term if you have fewer terms left in your program than the minimum time to completion at the point of eligibility. For example, if you have 2 terms left when one of your colleagues enrolls in an AUNE Education Department Program, you will receive \$500 for each of your two final terms.
