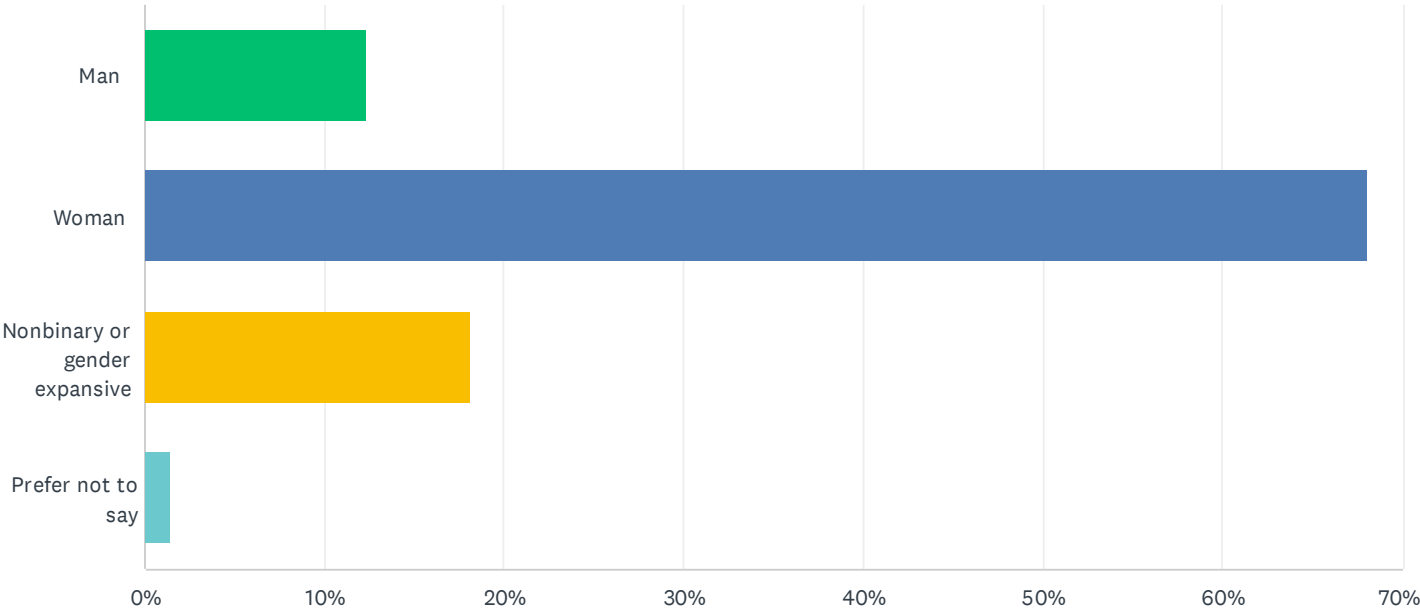

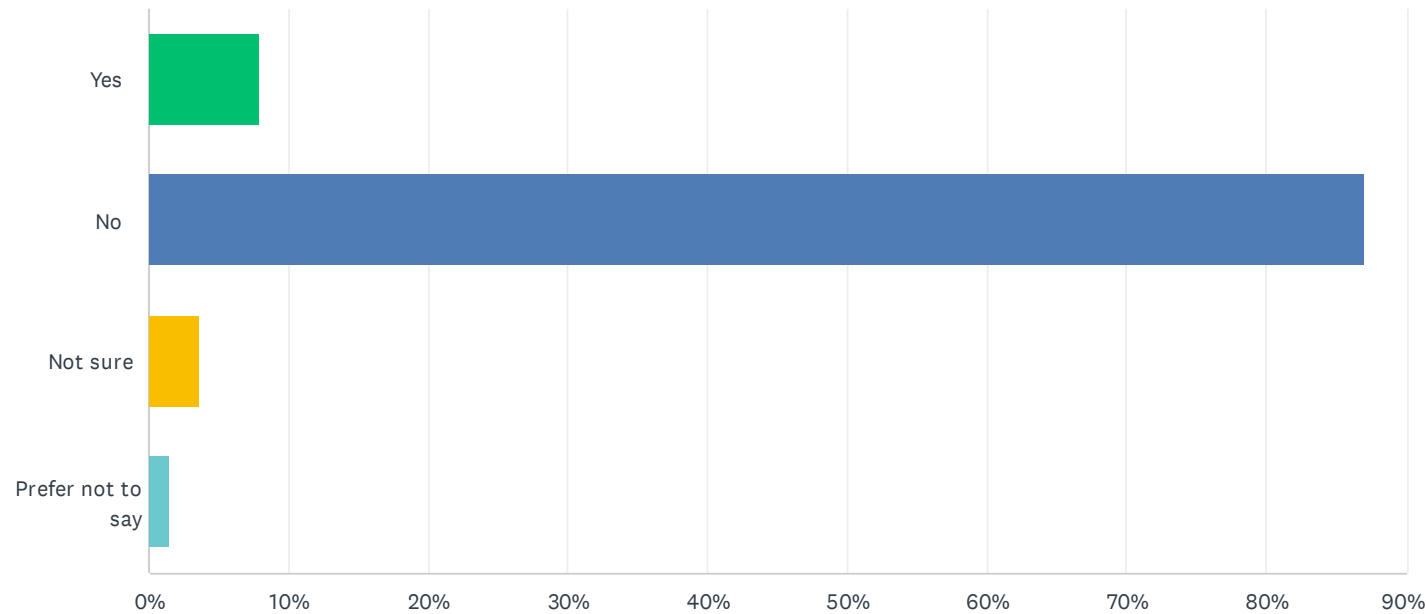

Q4 Do you identify as transgender?

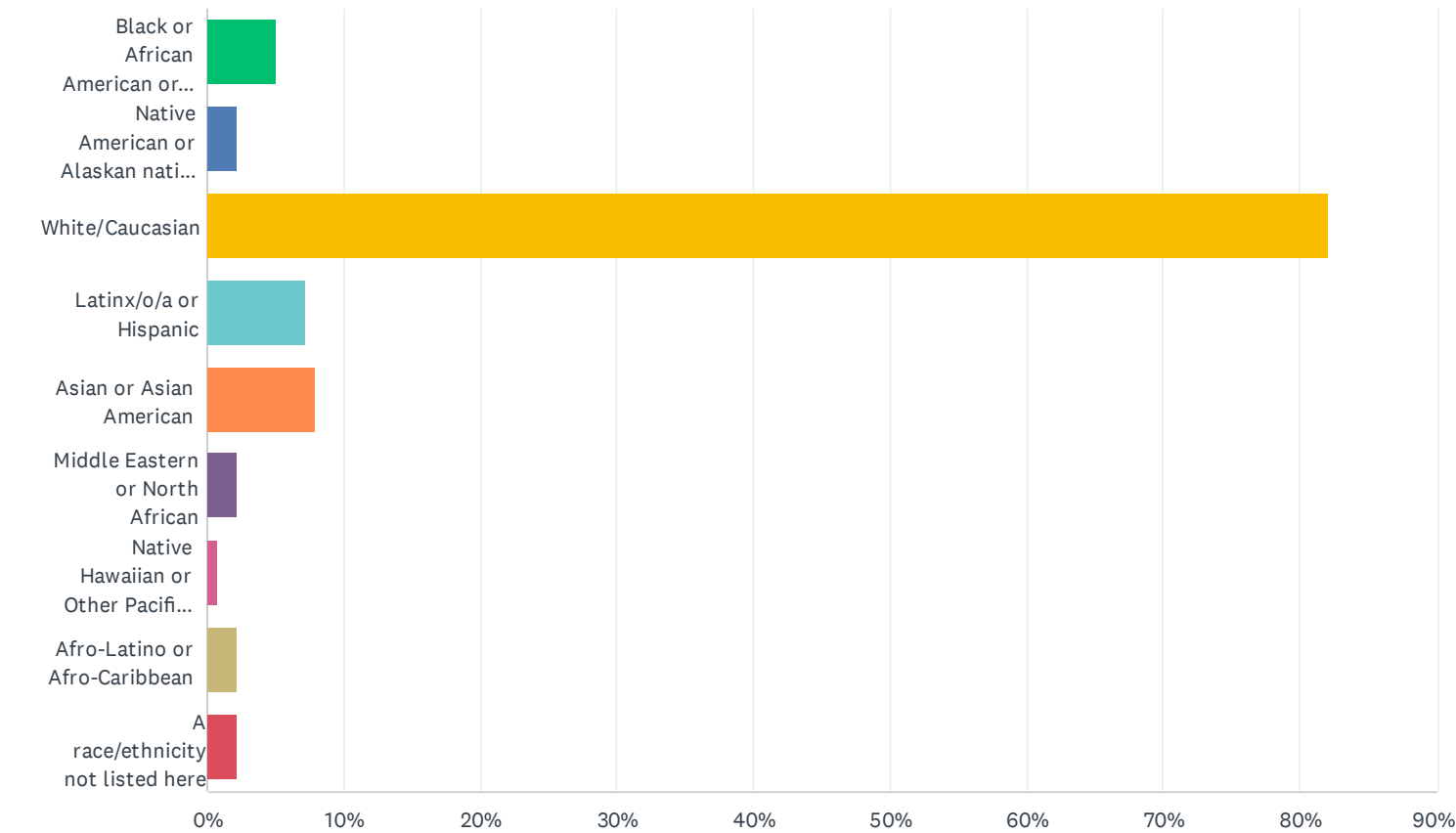

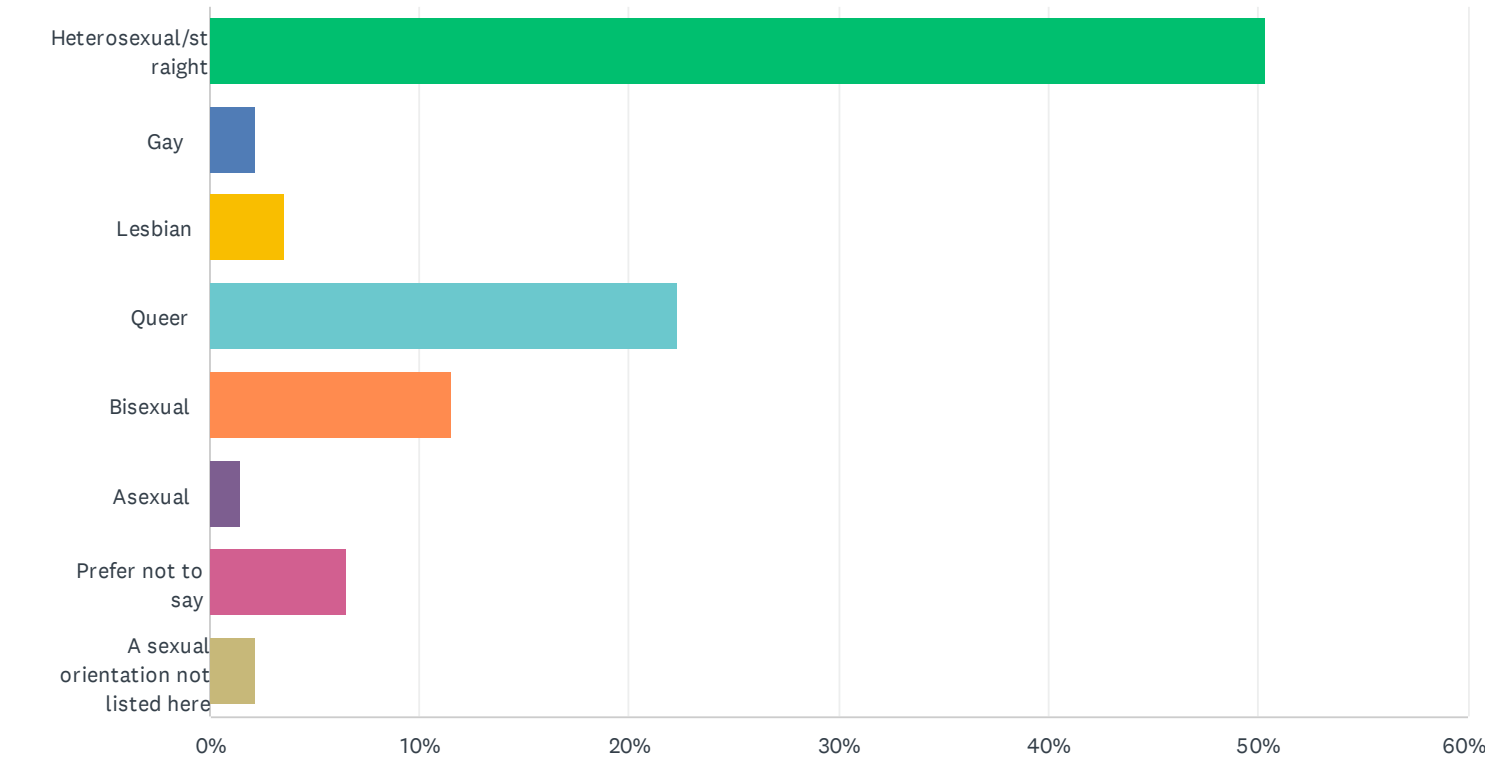

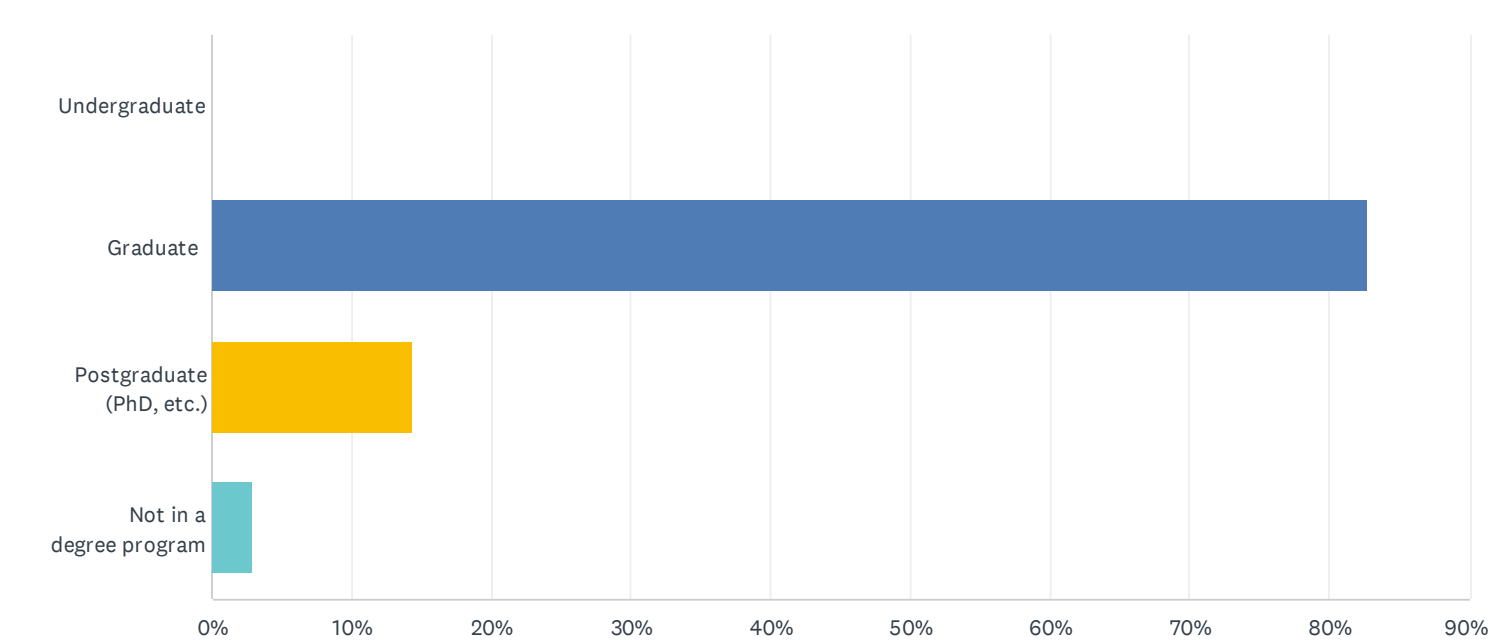

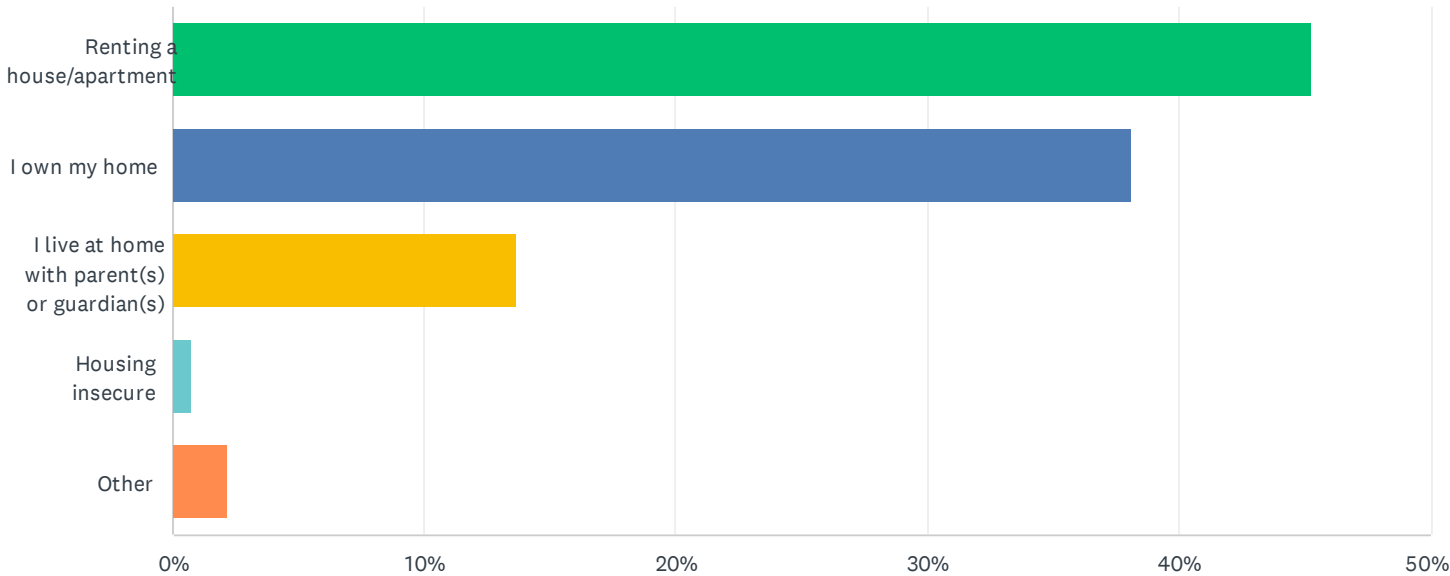

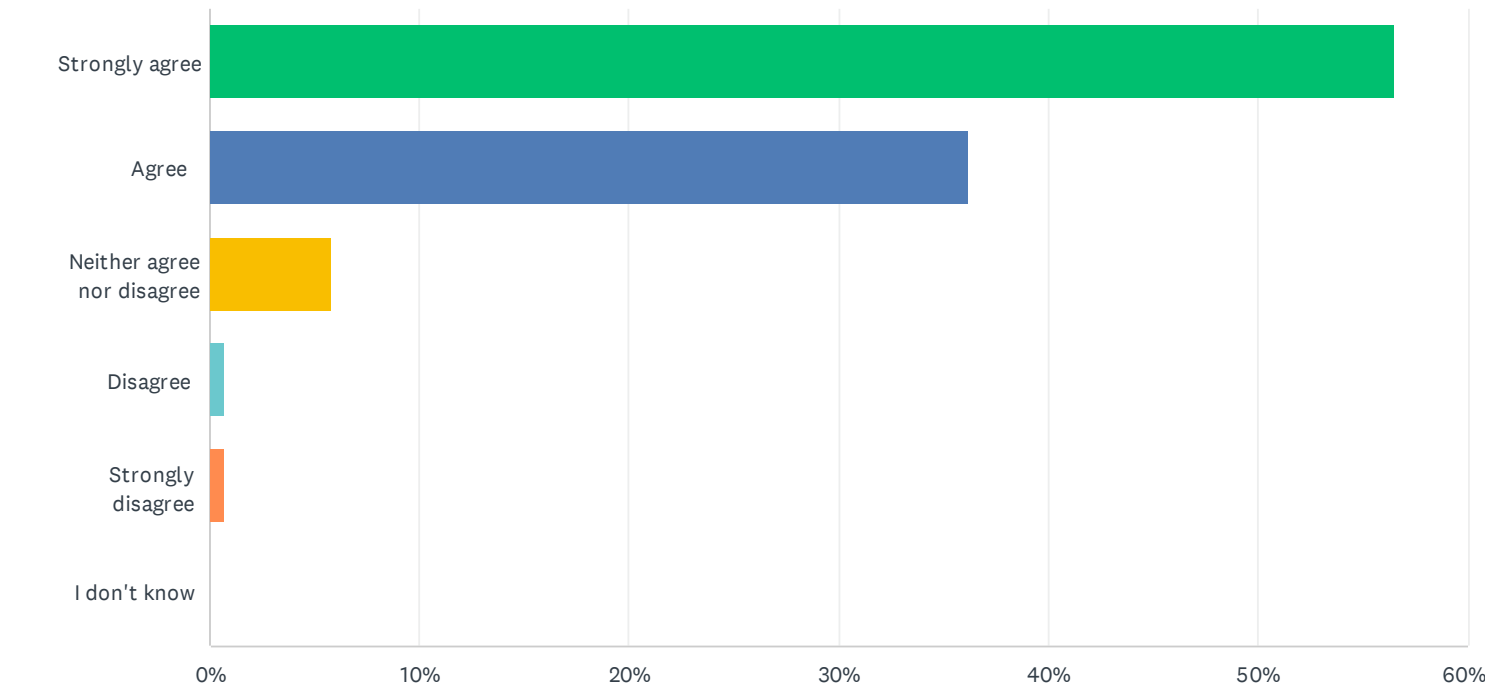

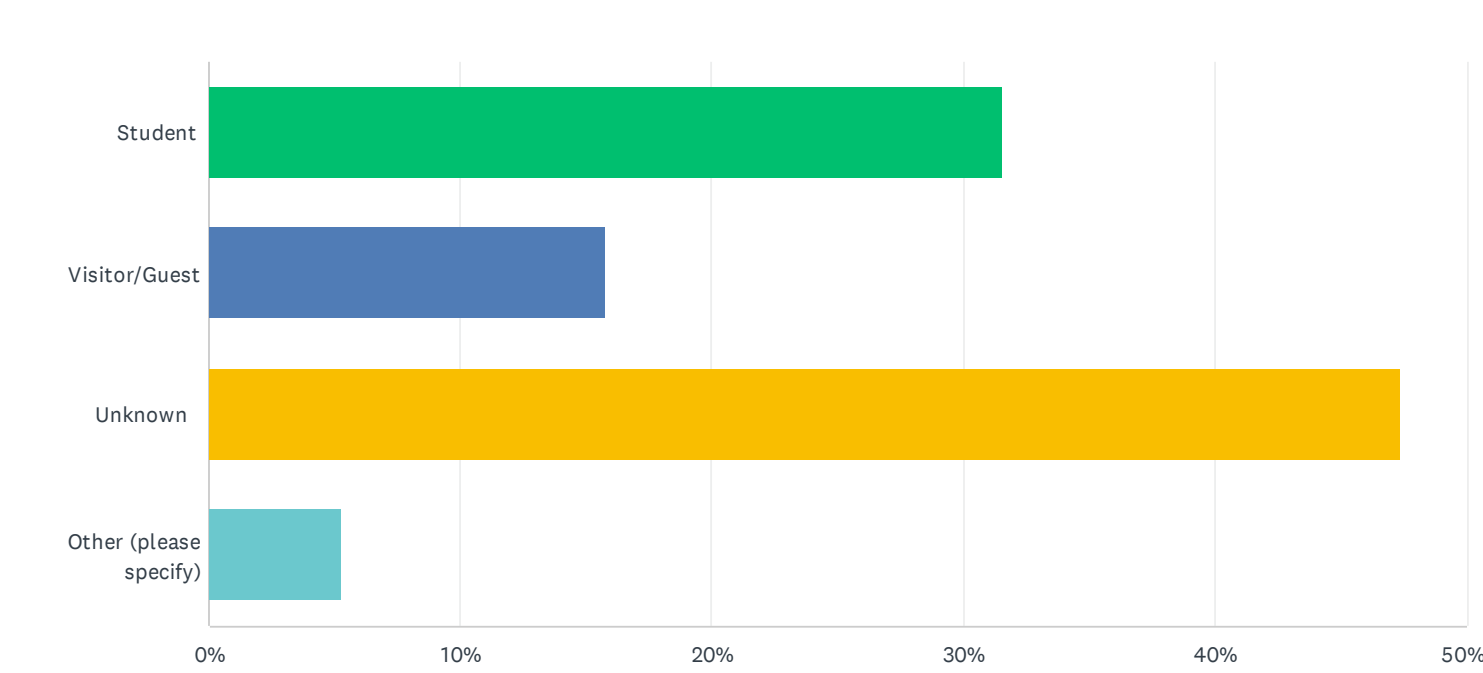

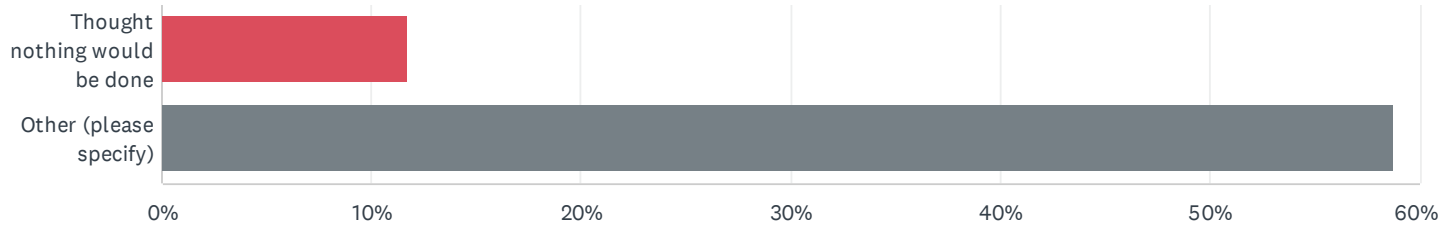

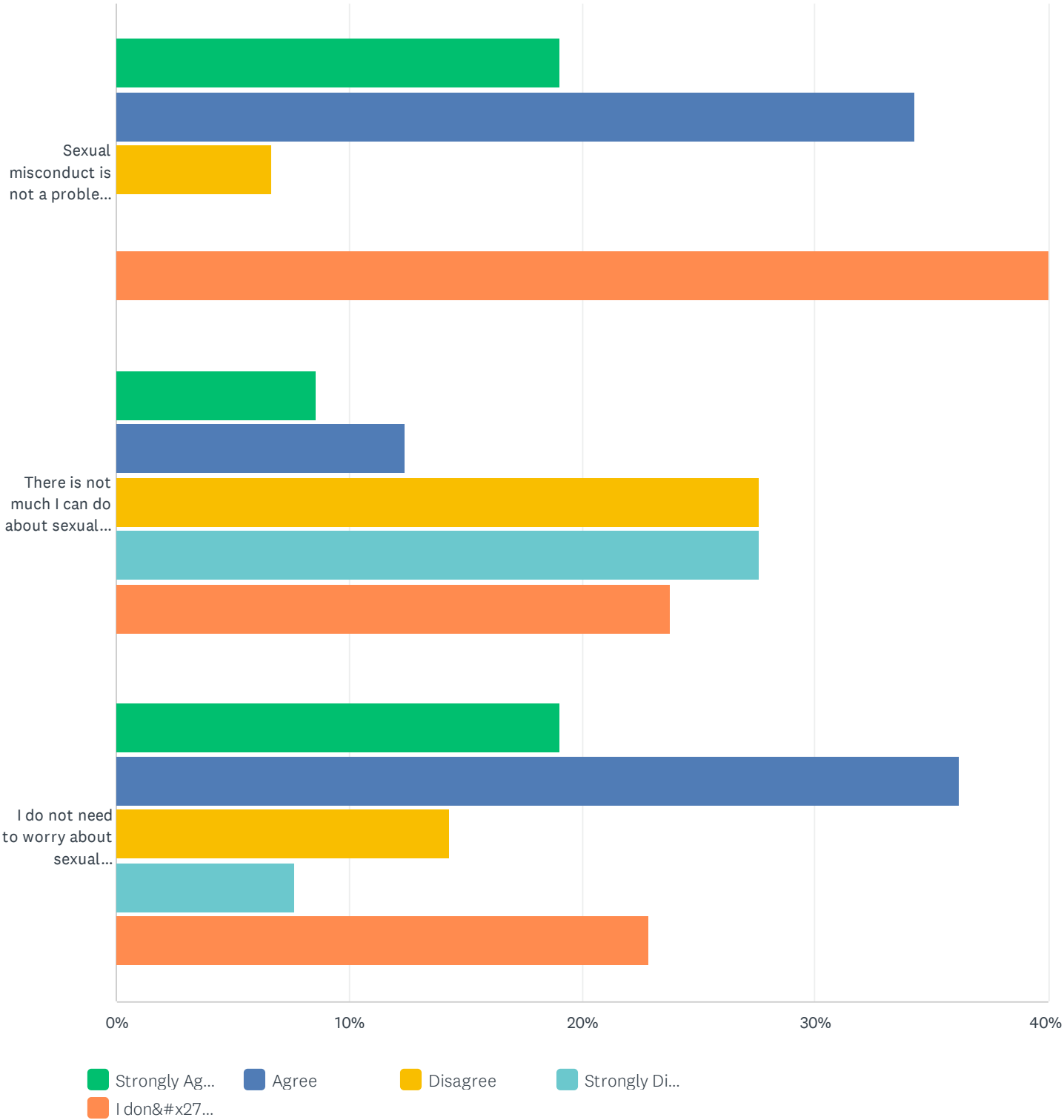
